1. National Legal Basis Relevant Senegalese laws: • Senegal Civil Code (French-based system – contracts, obligations, liability) • Consumer Protection Code (general consumer rights) • Electronic Transactions Law (Loi n° 2008-08) • Product Safety & Standards — ASN (Association Sénégalaise de Normalisation) • Code of Civil Procedure Jurisdiction: court where the rental occurs unless agreed otherwise. Contract validity: private rental agreements are enforceable under Senegalese civil-law principles.
2. Tax and Reporting Rental income is taxable. VAT (TVA): • Standard VAT rate: 18% Record keeping: minimum 10 years (Direction Générale des Impôts et des Domaines).
3. Liability and Insurance Liability requires: • negligence or fault • actual provable damage • causation Gross negligence or intent cannot be excluded. Template limits: • USD 270 per rental • USD 900 for Mobility Recommended insurance: • Civil liability insurance • Equipment/business insurance
4. Consumer Rights & Withdrawal Consumer Protection Code applies. No EU-style 14-day withdrawal right for fixed-date rental services. Refund rules: • Before handover: per agreement • After handover: only if item is defective, unsafe, or unusable.
5. Data Protection Applicable law: • Loi n° 2008-12 on Personal Data Protection Authority: CDP (Commission de Protection des Données Personnelles) Safe Standard® stores no personal data; Stripe processes all payments.
6. Enforcement & Cross-Border Cases Handled by Senegalese civil courts. Foreign judgments require exequatur. Arbitration allowed with written agreement.
7. Use of Templates in Senegal Annex is internal reference only. Steps: 1. Rental Agreement (Country: Senegal) 2. Focus Checklist at handover 3. Photo Rule — No notes = No damage = No photos 4. Damage Invoice if needed 5. Annex is NOT shared with renter.
